BIBLICAL FAITH

DEFINITIONS:

Faith is being confident in what we hope for, convinced about things we do not see. (Heb. 11:1)

Faith is trusting in the ability of God to manifest from the spirit realm what has been petitioned by believers.

I. Foundations of Faith

- A. Hearing the word of God (Rom. 10:17)
- B. Trusting in what God says (Heb. 11:3)
- C. Possessing hope or expectation (Heb. 11:1)

II. The Necessity of Faith

- A. Salvation is dependent upon faith (Rom. 5:1; Eph. 2:8)
- B. Impossible to please God without faith (Heb. 11:6)
- C. All things are received by faith (Healing, Promises, Miracles, Requests, etc.) (Mark 11:22-24)

III. Faith must be accompanied by action

A. Faith without works is dead (James 2:14-26)

IV. The Lifestyle of the Righteous

- A. The just shall live by his faith (Heb. 10:38)
- B. Everyone is given a measure of faith which makes the believer accountable to live by faith. (Rom. 12:3)
